0.0	0.0	<b>Start</b>	Rides from Alton Baker Park start in the plaza near the entrance, next to the parking lot and the pond. Cross over the Peter Defazio Bicycle Bridge to 4th Avenue
0.0	0.0		Ride across the Peter Defazio Bridge to 4th Street on the South side of the river
0.4	0.4	<b>L</b>	Left on 4th Street to High Street
0.7	0.3	<b>S</b>	Straight to Pearl Street
2.1	1.4	<b>L</b>	Left on Pearl to 19th Street (Pearl becomes Amazon Parkway)
2.5	0.4	<b>S</b>	Straight at stoplight at 24th Street
2.9	0.4	<b>BR</b>	Bear right at curve to intersection of Pearl and 27th Street. Proceed straight ahead.
3.8	1.0	<b>S</b>	Straight ahead on Pearl at stop sign
3.8	0.0	<b>R</b>	Turn right on 28th
4.8	1.0	<b>L</b>	Turn left on Oak
4.9	0.1	<b>R</b>	Turn right on 29th
5.0	0.0	<b>S</b>	Proceed West on 29th at Willamette Street
5.4	0.5	<b>BL</b>	Proceed up Lorane Highway where it intersects 29th Street
5.4	0.0	<b>S</b>	Straight on Lorane Hwy
6.8	1.4	<b>S</b>	Straight at Chambers
10.7	3.9	<b>S</b>	Straight on Spencer Creek
14.0	3.3	<b>R</b>	Right on Pine Grove
15.2	1.2	<b>R</b>	Right on Gimple Hill
19.9	4.7	<b>L</b>	Left on Bailey Hill Road
21.5	1.6	<b>R</b>	Right on Bailey Hill where Bertelsen goes straight.
23.1	1.6	<b>R</b>	Right on 18th St
23.4	0.3	<b>L</b>	Left on Quaker
23.8	0.4	<b>R</b>	Right on bicycle path, stay on bicycle path until it ends on Jefferson,
31.6	7.8	<b>S</b>	Bike path becomes 15th at Jefferson
32.3	0.7	<b>L</b>	Bike route turns left on High Street
33.2	0.85	<b>R</b>	4th Avenue
33.4	0.25	<b>R</b>	DeFazio bicycle bridge to park.
33.4	0	<b>Finish</b>	Start at base of Defazio Bike Bridge near the pond in Alton Baker Park
